The vetbe erans in this city are very desirous of mak log a fitting celebration of this great event, and the reorganization of Camp gli Bearing will be pushed forward with that end in view. The veterage hope to increase the already large membership to 500 and the names of every veteran in this city and vicinity will be enrolled. There will be a muster of all interested in a few days and ac ive preparations begun. Confederale Vateran Camps have been established everywhere, and in this respect TI Columbus has been far behind a number of her sieter cities which she far exceeds in size and importance. At the last reunion of ve erans, which was held at Hous-81 ton, Texas, some months ago, Columbus was not officially represented, though several of the lading ex Conf derate soldiers were in attendan e. It was there voted to hold the next re-union at R chmord, Va, and during the part few days General John B. Gordon, commander of the United Confederate Veterans, has issued E P an order naming Tuesday, June 30, Wedneeday and Thursday, July 1 and 2 as the dates for holding this reunion. R chmond was the storm center of the war and the crade of Confederate hopes, hence it is the purpose of all veterans to make this п reunion the grandest of all. 2 2 This is ano her reason of the many good once sasigned for reorganis ng the Colum-LP bus camp, and it is intended to send a large and enthu-islife delegation.
